## GUIDING PRACTICES

### GSLC Staff:

Expect and value engagement with families, school districts, agency providers and other involved persons in assisting, supporting, and guiding students to achieving their goals

Maintain appropriate professional credentials

Participate in ongoing professional development

## SERVICES PROVIDED

**GSLC provides day school services to students ages 5-20 who demonstrate the need for an intensive, highly structured and integrated therapeutic and educational program.**

### GSLC offers:

- Integrated clinical services supported by certified Behavioral Health Professionals.
- Applied learning daily and individualized classroom instruction to address learning needs
- Access to individualized web-based programs such as PLATO to provide credit recovery when needed.
- Frequent off campus learning experiences to enhance classroom instruction.
- Partners with sending school districts to provide state assessments and curriculum to meet each school's graduation requirements.
- Licensed mental health facility with participation in MaineCare.
- Licensed speech, language and occupational therapy providers.

The student's Individualized Education Plan (IEP) and Master Service Plan (MSP) serve as guiding documents throughout the school year. Students participate in a full day academic and recreation schedule. Off campus activities are scheduled no less than once monthly.

Maine's system of learning results or the Common Core standards serve as the framework for academic standards. High School students work towards academic credits in collaboration with their home school's requirements.
